### Grievance Procedures

# Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973/Americans with Disabilities Act (ADAAA)

It is the policy of the School Board of Broward County, Florida, not to discriminate against students with regard to access to programs, services and activities on the basis of disability. The steps below have been developed to comply with the law for resolution of individual complaints under Section 504/ADA. The aggrieved person is not required by law to exhaust the District's grievance procedures before filing a complaint with the Office for Civil Rights.

### **Local Grievance Procedure**

Parent/guardian/student can contact 504 Liaison located at child's school or contact the District 504/ADA Specialist, to obtain a Grievance Filing Form. Resolution is provided within 15 school days upon receipt of written grievance.

## **Impartial Hearing Procedure**

If the parent/guardian/student is not satisfied with the resolution issued as a result of the local grievance process, he/she may request an impartial hearing. The request for an impartial hearing would be submitted to:
