S E A R C H

Project SEARCH is a business-led total immersion transition program designed for students with disabilities. The students develop employability skills potentially leading to paid employment. Students work and learn vocational and social skills in various departments with hospital personnel as mentors. A certified teacher and job coach are onsite to instruct, supervise and support the students.

Student Entrance Criteria:

- Students must be between the ages of 17 and 21.
- Students must have completed credit/graduation requirements (with the exception of some elective credits) or are deferring receipt of their diploma.
- The Transition Individualized Education Plan must prescribe special education services in the area of employment/career development and related services through age 21.
- Desire to work competitively.
- Located at Hallandale and Cypress Bay High Schools.

- On-the-job training
- Independent Living Skills training
